

# CITY OF PRINCE ALBERT BYLAW NO. 23 OF 2008

*A Bylaw of The City of Prince Albert to Amend City Council's  
Procedure Bylaw No. 10 of 2005, as amended, with Respect to  
Proclamations and Inquiries.*

WHEREAS Bylaw No. 10 of 2005, has been passed pursuant to Section 55(b) of The Cities Act, to regulate the proceedings of City Council and its Committees; and,

WHEREAS City Council deems it necessary to further amend the Proclamation and Inquiries Section of the Bylaw.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PRINCE ALBERT IN OPEN MEETING ASSEMBLED ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Bylaw No. 10 of 2005, as amended, be further amended as follows:

Section 19 – Notice of Proclamations

- a. Delete – Section 4(a) in its entirety.

Insert – a New Section 4(a) as follows:

Promote any commercial business, unless, at the discretion of the Mayor, the Proclamation provides a significant benefit to the community.

2. Section 28 – Delete the Heading in its entirety.

– Insert a new heading as follows:

INQUIRIES AND REQUESTS FOR REPORTS

3. Section 28 Insert the following:

28(7) That any request for an Administrative Report during a City Council, Executive Committee or Committee of the Whole Council meeting, including the Inquiry Section of City Council meetings, must be made by Motion.

28(8) That members of Council include a due date within the Motion for requests of Administrative Reports, if the standard due date of sixty(60) days is insufficient.

28(9) That where practical, members of Council advise Administration six(6) hours prior to the meeting, when the Council Inquiry will be raised, to allow Administration the opportunity to investigate the matter and report their findings at the meeting.

28(10) That the City Manager be authorized to continually remove all stale issues from the Council Issue Tracking System that are no longer relevant to The City's focus and work plan, and issues that have been addressed verbally by Administration directly to the Member of Council or at a Council Meeting.

4. This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect on, from and after the final passing thereof.

READ A THIRD TIME AND PASSED THIS 2 DAY OF JULY ,AD 2008.
