

CITY OF PRINCE ALBERT BYLAW NO. 32 OF 2007

A bylaw of The City of Prince Albert to amend the Prohibition of Motorized Vehicles in Public Places Bylaw, being Bylaw No. 11 of 2007, as amended.

WHEREAS the Council of The City of Prince Albert deems desirable to amend Bylaw No. 11 of 2007 to clarify the prohibition provision, to expand the exemptions to the Bylaw and to repeal the Snowmobile Bypass Route Bylaw No. 9 of 1996.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PRINCE ALBERT IN OPEN MEETING ASSEMBLED ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Section 4 of Bylaw No. 11 of 2007 is hereby deleted and a new Section 4 is substituted therefore to read as follows:

"PROHIBITION OF MOTORIZED VEHICLES

4. Except for those motor vehicles lawfully authorized to operate on a street or travelled portion of a highway within the City of Prince Albert, no person shall operate a motorized vehicle anywhere within the corporate limits of the City of Prince Albert."

2. Section 5 is hereby amended by adding a new subsection 5(g) to read as follows:

"(g) such other motor vehicles as may be exempted by City Council".


3. Bylaw No. 9 of 1996 is hereby repealed.

4. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on, from and after the final passing thereof.
