

CITY OF PRINCE ALBERT BYLAW NO. 8 of 2011

*A Bylaw of the City of Prince Albert to amend
the Traffic Bylaw,
Bylaw No.16 of 2005.*

WHEREAS, it is deemed expedient to amend Bylaw No. 16 of 2005 for the purpose of, amending parking fines, updating Schedule 70 and Schedule 55(b)

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PRINCE ALBERT IN OPEN MEETING ASSEMBLED ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That section 72 (c) be deleted and the following new section be substituted therefore:

- c) Subject to the provisions of Subsection e) hereof, the driver of every vehicle shall forthwith, upon parking within a parking stall, cause to be deposited in the meter relating to such stall or multispace parking machine relating to the corresponding parking area, the proper coinage to attain to required time fore which the vehicle is intended to be parked in the parking stall. Such deposits shall entitle the vehicle to be parked in the stall for a time not exceeding that indicate, provided that prior to the expiry of such time, the driver may make a similar deposit to further extend the parking time of the vehicle within the parking stall up to the maximum time as indicated for the parking stall. A vehicle shall not park in a metered stall longer than the maximum time allowed on the meter.

2. That section 85 be deleted and the following new section be substituted therefore:

"Parking fines under Part XI

85. Notwithstanding Section 79, where any person commits or is alleged to have committed an infraction of any provision of this Bylaw relating to the parking of vehicles under Part XI of this Bylaw, any person being either a parking meter inspector or a parking meter supervisor in the employ of The City of Prince Albert or a member of the City of Prince Albert Police Service may give to such person, either personally, by mail or by attaching the same to the vehicle concern, a Notice of Violation in a form to be approved by the Chief of Police and requiring such person to appear at City Hall to pay to the employee in charge of the desk thereat, as a penalty for the specific infraction described in such notice, the sum of:

- a) Three Hundred (\$300.00) dollars if the infraction or alleged infraction is in respect to Section 61 (a) of this Bylaw;
- b) One Hundred (\$100.00) dollars if the infraction or alleged infraction is in respect to Section 61 (b) of this Bylaw;
- c) Twenty-five (\$25.00) dollars if the infraction or alleged infraction is in respect of:
 - I. A provision of Section 60 of this Bylaw;
 - II. A provision of this Bylaw relating to the parking of a vehicle, other than a bus, in a bus stop pursuant to Section 77;
 - III. A provision of this Bylaw relating to the parking of a vehicle, other than a designated taxi, in a taxi stand, pursuant to Section 78;
 - IV. A provision of this Bylaw relating to the parking in a loading zone of a vehicle that is neither named or designated by sign for the zone, or parking of a permitted vehicle beyond the time specified in the resolution and named in the sign for the zone, or the parking of a vehicle having a parking permit issued under this Bylaw on a street in the Central Business District in a manner contrary to the provisions of the permit; or
 - V. If the infraction or alleged infraction is in respect of a provision of this Bylaw relating to the parking of vehicles under Part XI of this Bylaw, other than infractions in respect to Section 61 of this Bylaw.

Compliance with such Notice at any time prior to the initiation of a prosecution in respect of the infraction described in the Notice shall relieve the person to whom the Notice has been issued from liability to such prosecution. If payment is received within seven (7) days of issuance of such Notice, Council hereby authorizes the Officer, Constable or employee in charge to accept in payment thereof the sum of:

- d) One hundred fifty (\$150.00) dollars in the case of a Notice issued in respect of an infraction mentioned in a) above;
- e) Fifty (\$50.00) dollars in the case of a Notice issued in respect of an infraction mentioned in b) above;
- f) Ten (\$10.00) dollars in the case of a Notice issued in respect of an infraction mentioned in c) above.

Provided that if payment is received after thirty (30) days of issuance of such Notice, or upon conviction being entered, the penalty for the specific infraction described in such Notice, shall be a minimum of:

- g) Four hundred fifty (\$450.00) dollars in the case of a Notice issued in respect of an infraction mentioned in a) above;
- h) Two hundred (\$200.00) dollars in the case of a Notice issued in respect of an infraction mentioned in b) above;

- i) Seventy-five (\$75.00) dollars in the case of a Notice issued in respect of an infraction mentioned in c) above.


Non-compliance with any Notice issued pursuant to this Section shall not in any way affect or prejudice the right of the person named in the notice to defend any charge which subsequently may be laid against such a person in respect of the infraction described in the Notice.

- 3. That Schedule "70" with respect to the "Metered Parking Area" appended to Bylaw #16 of 2005 be deleted and Schedule "70" appended hereto be substituted therefore, and all references to section "70" in Bylaw # 16 of 2005 shall refer to the attached.
- 4. That Schedule "55(b)" with respect to "school zones" appended to Bylaw # 16 of 2005 be deleted and Schedule "55 (b)" appended hereto be substituted therefore, and all references to section "55 (b)" in Bylaw # 16 of 2005 shall refer to the attached.
- 5. This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect on, from and after the final passing thereof.

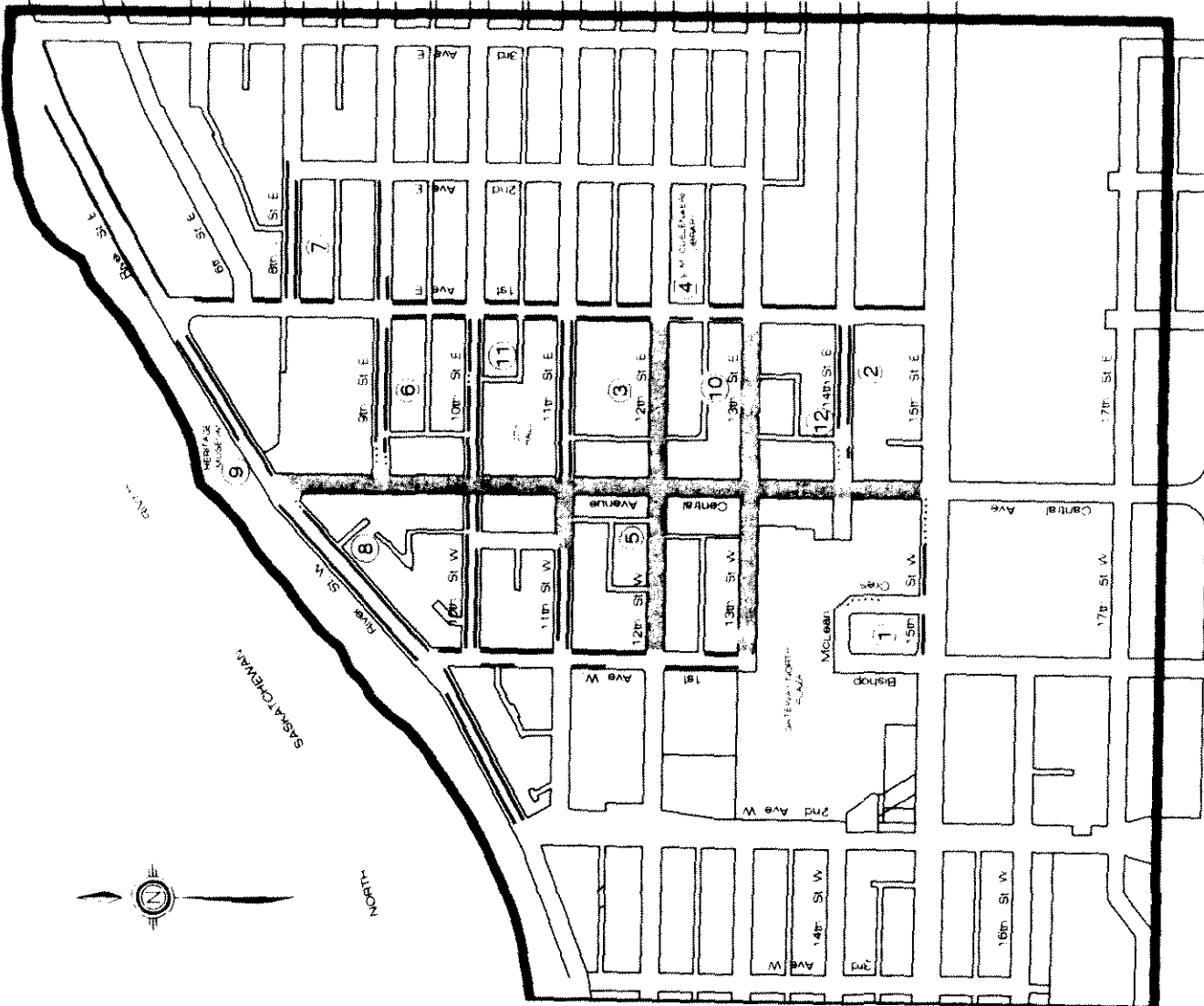

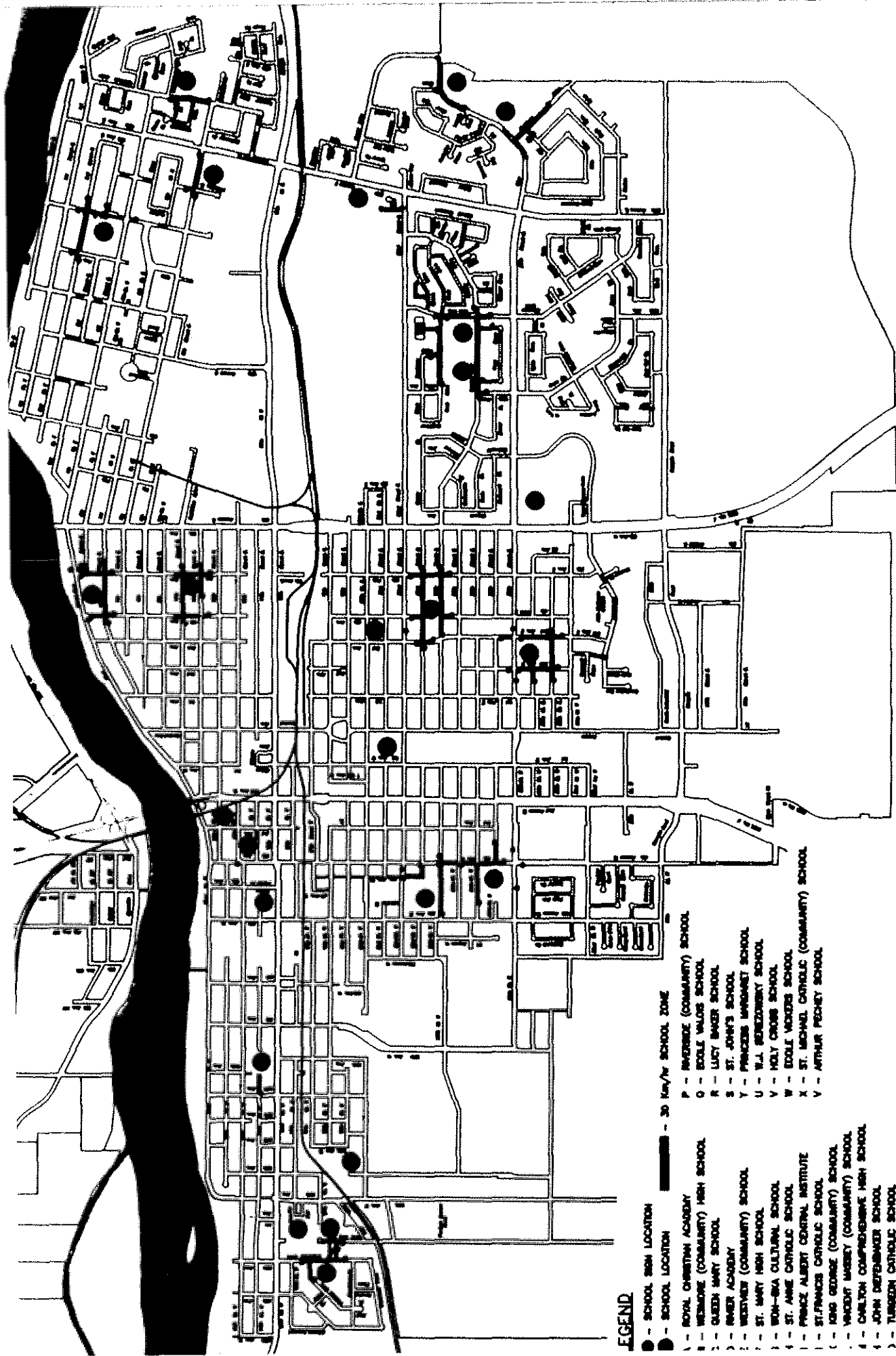
