

BYLAW NO.18 OF 1943

A Bylaw to amend Bylaw No.19 of 1935, covering the tethering-out of certain animals.

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to provide for the temporary tethering-out of animals in other districts than authorized by Bylaw No.19 of 1935;


NOW THEREFORE THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PRINCE ALBERT IN OPEN MEETING ASSEMBLED ENACT AS FOLLOWS:


1. The following section is inserted immediately after Section 1 of Bylaw No.19 of 1935 as section 1.a.

1.a. The Council may by resolution permit the tethering-out of animals in areas to be defined in the resolution other than the agricultural district of the City, for limited periods of time to be set forth in such resolution.

2. This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect on from and after the day of the final passing thereof.
