BYLAW NO. 19 OF 1961

A Bylaw to regulate the use
of dangerous weapons within
the City of Prince Albert.

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to enact a Bylaw to regulate the use of dangerous weapons within the limits of the City of Prince Albert.


NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PRINCE ALBERT IN OPEN MEETING ASSEMBLED ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:


1. No person shall discharge firearms, or guns or use a sling or catapult of any description or any other dangerous weapon within the limits of the City of Prince Albert. Provided that this section shall not apply to a recognized gun club or similar organization which has obtained a permit in writing from the Chief Constable entitling such organization to operate for the purpose of supervised target practice or similar activities, and the Chief Constable is hereby authorized to issue such permits.
2. A person guilty of a violation of this Bylaw is, upon summary conviction, liable to a fine not exceeding \$100.00 and in default of payment the offender may be imprisoned for a term of not more than Thirty (30) days.
3. This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect, on, from and after the final passing thereof.
