

CITY OF PRINCE ALBERT BYLAW NO. 46 OF 2011

A bylaw of The City of Prince Albert to amend the False Alarm Bylaw being Bylaw No. 39 of 2004.

WHEREAS the Council of The City of Prince Albert deems desirable to amend Bylaw No. 39 of 2004 to increase subscription and assessment fees relative to the alarm business response service provided by the Prince Albert Police Service.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PRINCE ALBERT IN OPEN MEETING ASSEMBLED ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Subsection 2 of Section 5 of Bylaw No. 39 of 2004 is hereby deleted and a new subsection 5(2) is substituted therefore to read as follows:

"ALARM SYSTEM IDENTIFICATION NUMBER

- 5(2). Each alarm business shall pay the Police Service a subscription fee of \$25.00 for each premises per year, the initial payment to be made within ninety (90) days of this Bylaw coming into force and on or before each anniversary date thereafter."

2. Section 7 is hereby deleted and a new section 7 is substituted therefore to read as follows:

"ASSESSMENT OF FEES

7. An alarm business which reports the activation of an alarm to the Police Service using the 1-900 telephone alarm line shall pay a fee of \$100.00 plus applicable taxes for each call."

COMING INTO FORCE


3. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the day of its final passing.
