

CITY OF PRINCE ALBERT
BYLAW NO. 49 OF 1967

A Bylaw to amend the Bylaw with respect
to private crossings over sidewalks
and boulevards.

WHEREAS it is deemed advisable to amend Bylaw No. 43
of 1965 being a Bylaw to regulate private crossings over side-
walks and boulevards;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PRINCE ALBERT
IN OPEN MEETING ASSEMBLED ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. There shall be added to Section 2(b) of the said
Bylaw No. 43 of 1965 the following subsection:


2(c) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection
2(b) next preceding, where a single dwelling
unit exists, before the application for a
crossing permit, having existing sideyards
of less than ten (10) feet a permit may be
granted for a crossing having one side of
the crossing at the property line and the
other side not more than five (5) feet from
a projection to the front line of the site
of the line of the side wall of the house,
nearest to the said property line, provided,
however, that such crossing shall not be
placed within twenty-five (25) feet from the
corner of a street measured from the property
line.


2. This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect on,
from and after the final passing thereof.
