BYLAW NO. 54 OF 1973

CITY OF PRINCE ALBERT.

A Bylaw to amend the Bylaw with respect to  
private crossings over sidewalks and boulevards.

WHEREAS it is deemed advisable to amend Bylaw No. 43 of 1965, as amended, being a Bylaw to regulate private crossings over sidewalks and boulevards;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PRINCE ALBERT IN OPEN MEETING ASSEMBLED ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Sections 2(b) and 2(c) of the said Bylaw No. 43 of 1965, as amended be deleted and the following new Section 2(b) be substituted therefor:

"2(b) A crossing or crossings in a residential zone may be permitted to be partially or wholly in front of a residential building if:


- (i) it provides access to a garage or carport or;
- (ii) it provides access to a legal or legal non-conforming parking space under the terms of the City Zoning Bylaw and;
- (iii) it provides access to a parking space or spaces required by the City Zoning Bylaw and;
- (iv) except in the case of (i) above, it commences at a side property line and;
- (v) all other provisions of this bylaw are met."


2. This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect on, from and after the final passing thereof.
