BYLAW NO. 60 OF 1974.

A bylaw of the City of Prince Albert to amend the bylaw with respect to private crossings over sidewalks and boulevards.  
-----

WHEREAS it is deemed advisable to amend Bylaw No. 43 of 1965, as amended, being a bylaw to regulate private crossings over sidewalks and boulevards;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PRINCE ALBERT IN OPEN MEETING ASSEMBLED ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Section 9 of the said Bylaw No. 43 of 1965, be deleted and the following new Section 9 be substituted therefore:

"9. In Agricultural, Small and Large Acreage, and Residential Zones under the City's Zoning Bylaw, no single crossing shall exceed ten feet in width, and in all other areas single crossings shall not exceed twenty feet in width, subject to the right of City Council to approve crossings of greater width where it can be demonstrated that the physical requirement of any single vehicle servicing a premises requires such increased crossing width."

2. This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect on from and after the final passing thereof.
