## West Hill Road Closures

*This Summer*

The West Hill Construction Project will require some road closures for the duration of the summer.

Please be advised that the intersection at 6th Avenue West and 28th Street will be closed beginning Sunday, May 31, 2009

Access will be restricted for the businesses on 28th Street between 4th and 6th Avenue West and patrons may be required to find an alternate access through the back alley

It is expected that this intersection will be open on Monday, June 15, 2009. However, the construction schedule is subject to change depending on weather conditions and other mitigating factors. Ongoing updates will be provided throughout the summer

### Transit Routes
