



**CITY OF PRINCE ALBERT
APPOINTMENTS TO CIVIC COMMITTEES, COMMISSIONS AND BOARDS**

Each year, The City of Prince Albert invites its residents to consider serving on its various Committees, Commissions and Boards to fill vacancies.

Citizens who wish to take an active role on one of the Civic Committees, Commissions or Boards must forward an Application Form, together with a resume and two (2) references in order for their interest to be made known to members of City Council, when considering appointments.

Application forms can be obtained from the City Clerk's Office, City Hall or from the City's website at www.citypa.ca. All Applications are kept on file in order to fill any vacancies that occur throughout the year.

Information on each Committee, Commission and Board is summarized below, however, City Council reserves the right to add or delete any Committee, Commission or Board during its deliberations.

BODY	PURPOSE
Economic Development Advisory Committee	To provide advice and feedback to the Department of Economic Development on policies as they affect the community and for developing business attraction processes, building networks for development and acting as ambassadors for the City.
Golf Course Advisory Committee	To provide input on matters of planning and policy development for the Cooke Municipal Golf Course, as well as any other golf course matters referred to it by City Council, the Mayor and the City Manager.
Housing Advisory	To review various housing issues ranging from availability, property standards, enforcement and social issues.
Museum and Heritage Advisory Committee	To provide input on matters relating to Museums in the City and to advise, assist and make recommendations regarding the preservation, interpretation, development and designation of Heritage Properties within the City.
Race Relations and Social Issues Advisory Committee	To consider and make recommendations with respect to issues related to race relations and social issues within the community of Prince Albert.
Transit Advisory Committee	To provide advice and feedback on the City's transit operations and make recommendations for improvement.
Board of Police Commissioners	To provide general direction, long term planning, policy and priorities to the Police Service.
Board of Revision	To rule on evidence submitted as to the equity of the assessed values in place for properties and businesses and to hear local improvement assessment appeals.
Development Appeals Board	To hear appeals authorized by The Planning and Development Act relating to matters such as the Zoning Bylaw or Development Permits.
John M. Cuelenaere Public Library Board	Responsible for the overall operation of the local library.
Beautification Subcommittee	To promote, advise and recommend programs to beautify the City.
Prince Albert Municipal Heritage Award Selection Subcommittee	To make recommendations regarding the selection and recognition of Heritage work in Prince Albert through the presentation of awards.
Prince Albert and District Community Futures Corporation Board of Directors	To help enhance regional economic development in Prince Albert and surrounding area, provide advice to new and expanding small businesses and provide loans to enterprises that cannot access conventional funding.
Prince Albert and District Community Service Centre Board	To provide input into programs such as Pine Industries, Work Preparation Centre, Budget Counselling, Steps to Employment, Prince Albert Supported Employment, Youth Employment Support Program, Transition Services, and Special Needs and Seniors Transportation.
Prince Albert Arts Board Inc.	To develop, promote, administer and co-ordinate Arts policies, program, facilities and issues of the Arts in the City of Prince Albert.

Please note the following:

- All appointments are served on a volunteer basis, except the Board of Revision and the Prince Albert Development Appeals Board, whose members receive a small remuneration for each meeting attended.
- All Committee, Commission and Board appointments expire December 31, 2010, unless otherwise indicated.

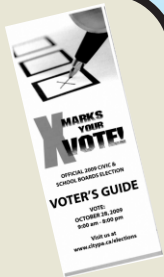
