The landfill is open 8:00 am - 6:30 pm - Monday to Saturday. Closed Sundays, Christmas Day and New Year's Day.



The final free week at the landfill for 2009 will be the week of Dec. 28 to 31 for all non-commercial hauls. All loads must be covered or secured when hauling waste to the Landfill.

Residents may dispose of a maximum of four (4) passenger vehicle tires (off the rims). Commercial tires will not be accepted.

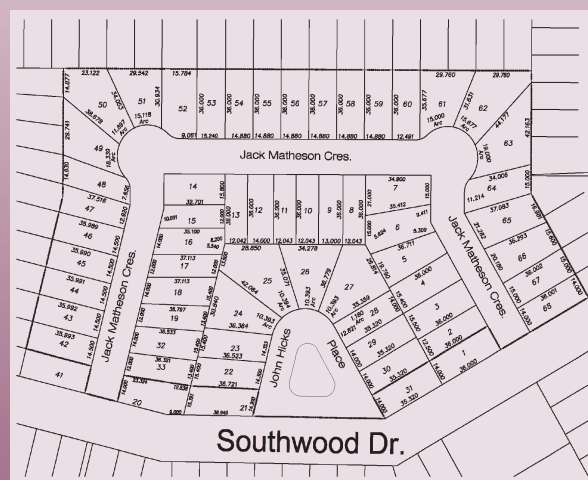
### Jack Matheson Crescent & John Hicks Place
