PUBLIC NOTICE ZONING BYLAW AMENDMENT - BYLAW NO. 1 OF 2010

Public Notice is hereby given that the Council of The City of Prince Albert intends to consider Bylaw No. 1 of 2010 to amend Bylaw No. 1 of 1987, known as The City of Prince Albert Zoning Bylaw.

Reason for Amendment: Bylaw No. 1 of 2010, is proposing to include provisions to regulate the placement of shipping containers throughout the city. Shipping Containers will be added to Section 4 (General provisions) of the Zoning Bylaw with the following regulations:

- The containers meeting all the setbacks and applicable provisions contained in the Zoning Bylaw
- A Building Permit is obtained
- An engineering report is provided to verify the structural integrity and compliance with load states design as per the National Building Codes
- No human occupation and/or habitation is permitted.

Shipping containers shall be considered as an accessory building, structure or use in the Zoning Bylaw and therefore shall comply with all the provisions of Accessory Buildings, Structures and Uses contained in the Zoning Bylaw.

Shipping Container will be defined as any container that is used for the temporary storage of goods while they are being transported from one place to another. It does not include semi-trailer units, truck boxes, portable construction site units or any other similar type of conveyance.

Shipping Containers may be located as a stand alone use or building only in the case of Transfer Yards, and Storage Facilities.

Shipping containers may be located temporarily on a lot in accordance with sections 4.6 (General Provisions- Temporary Accessory Structures), but not in accordance with sections 15.2 (Commercial Zone-Temporary Buildings, Structures and Uses) and 21.2 (Industrial Zone- Temporary Buildings, Structures and Uses) of the Zoning Bylaw.

Shipping containers shall be prohibited in all Zones except in the M1 (Heavy Industrial), M2 (Light Industrial High Density), M3 (Light Industrial Medium Density), M4 (Airport Industrial), C3 (Arterial Commercial), C4 (Highway Commercial)

Monday, February 22, 2010 at 7:00 pm in City Hall Council Chambers, 1084 Central Avenue, Prince Albert, SK.

Therefore, in accordance with City Council's Procedure Bylaw No.10 of 2005, all written submissions must be signed and provided to the City Clerk. If you would like your written submission reviewed by members of Council prior to the meeting, you are required to provide your submission by 4:45 p.m. on Tuesday February 16, 2010.
