**STREET OILING  
PROGRAM**

Street Oiling started this week in the East Flat. Once completed, crews will move to the West Flat, followed by Hazeldell and Nordale. "No Parking" signs will be posted on the streets the day before oiling occurs. Residents are asked to ensure vehicles are moved off the street to accommodate City equipment and proper street oiling.

**RESIDENTIAL STREET  
SWEEPING**

The Residential Street Cleaning program is underway. The planned order of residential sweeping for 2010 is as follows:

1. Midtown
2. East Flat/Riverview
3. Crescent Heights, Crescent Acres, Carlton Park
4. East Hill
5. West Hill
6. West Flat/Westview
7. Nordale/Hazeldell/North Industrial

Residential areas will be signed 24 hours in advance of any street sweeping. Residents can help out City crews by ensuring that parked vehicles are moved from signed areas. The removal of the parked vehicles will allow crews to thoroughly clean all areas of the street.

Please note that this schedule is just a guideline and that garbage collection can affect the sweeping schedule as we do not sweep areas on garbage or recycle collection days when bins may be on the front street.

**RESIDENTIAL PROPERTY  
REINSPECTION PROGRAM**

As part of its ongoing commitment to fairness and equity in property taxation the City's Property Assessment Division has implanted a re-inspection of all homes in the City of Prince Albert.

This confirmation of property details will ensure that everyone is paying their fair share of the property taxes required to run the city.

Staff from the City Property Assessment Division will be conducting property inspections in Ward 8 (Councillor Ted Zurakowski) during the week of June 7th to June 11th. Each assessor has photo identification to show that they are the individuals authorized by the city under provincial legislation to conduct the inspections. We would ask for the cooperation of residents in helping us complete this legislatively required inspection process.

We ask that each homeowner co-operate with city staff by allowing the access to their homes in a timely manner, once the assessors have produced their City identification.

**HEIGHT OF FENCES**

Zoning Bylaw No. 1 of 1987 states that the maximum height of a front yard fence is 1.22 metres (4 feet) and the maximum allowable height for rear and side yard fences is 1.9 metres (6 feet and 2 inches).

Property owners have until June 1, 2011, to ensure that property fence heights conform to the City's Zoning Bylaw No. 1 of 1987. After June 1, 2011, any non-compliant fences that are reported to the City will be investigated and will be required to be corrected within the strict timeframes of the provisions in the applicable Bylaw.
