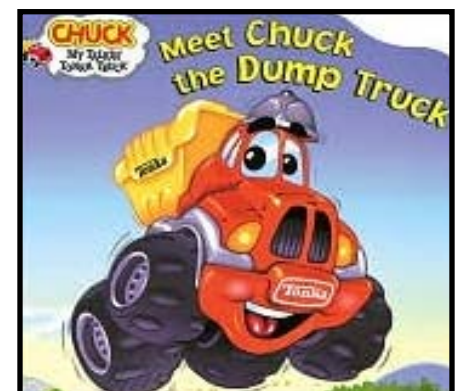

### FREE Skateboard Lessons

Fun class for beginner skateboarders. Children and youth will learn the basics of skateboarding including park etiquette, safety, balance, and elementary tricks. Learn proper foot placement, pushing, riding, turning, safe approaches to ramps as well as an introduction to an "ollie" and "dropping in". Class includes instruction and supervised skate time.

Required equipment: Skateboard, helmet and water. Knee and elbow pads are also recommended.

### FREE BMX Lessons

For children and teenagers just beginning to ride a BMX bike at the skate-park. Develop beginner and intermediate BMX/Freestyle skills such as dropping in, jumps, gaps and grinds. Class includes instruction and supervised bike time.

Required equipment: BMX/Freestyle bike, helmet and water. Knee and elbow pads are also recommended.
