



2012 Bookings at the Kinsmen Water Park

In planning activities for school wind-ups or class functions, treat yourself to an afternoon at the Kinsmen Water Park. This facility is one of the largest Water Parks in the province and is suitable for children of all ages.

In addition to the 2 giant slides, the river ride, and the youth slide, the Park also has a swimming pool, a hot pool, a whirlpool capable of accommodating 25 - 30 people, as well as play apparatus and a canteen.

For the safety of all children, the Kinsmen Water Park is staffed with trained aquatic personnel so that your day at the Park will be safe and enjoyable. **We do however require the assistance of parents and/or supervisors in the water. Our policy "all children under the age of 8 must be accompanied by an adult in the water" will be strictly enforced. Please make all teachers aware of this policy.** As a result of our policy, supervisors will be admitted free of charge to the Water Park at the following ratio:

Kindergarten, Gr. 1 & Gr. 2	One adult supervisor in the water for every 3 children
Grade 3 & higher	One adult supervisor per class

Any additional supervisors or parents will be charged the below noted admission prices.

Children (12 years of age & under)	\$3.75
Students (13 - 18 years of age)	\$4.50
Adults (over 18 years of age)	\$5.25
Spectators	\$2.75

Class/school bookings are available on weekdays commencing June 4, 2012 between 1:00 and 7:00 p.m.

**Appropriate swimwear must be worn by all swimmers
(no cut-offs, cotton shorts or cotton T-shirts)**

If your class or school is interested in booking an outing at the Park, please contact the Frank J Dunn Swimming Pool at 953-4829 from **March 1st** to May 2nd or the Kinsmen Water Park at 953-4835 (after May 2nd), Monday through Friday between 8:30 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. Please ask for Lorri or Nicole.

- A maximum of 550 students will be booked on any one day, so book early!

****Bulk tickets** are also available for \$2.50 /child, \$3.00/student and \$3.50/adult. Minimum amount to purchase is 300. Team up with another school !!! Save and use again for next year!!!

To facilitate an efficient entry into the Park, it is recommended that admission fees are collected in advance and paid in one lump sum or by cheque payable to the City of Prince Albert.
