Plowing and removal of snow along Olympic Relay Route – remove vehicles

From 4 AM to 7AM on Monday, January 11 – expect traffic delays and equipment noises along Central Avenue 15 to River Street

The City of Prince Albert advises motorists that, to ensure Olympic Relay Torch bearers have a safe and clear path downtown, city crews will be working to plow and remove snow on Central Avenue, from 15th Street to River Street on the morning of January 11, 2010, from 4 AM to 7 AM. This activity could cause some traffic delays and equipment noise for residences along the route, the public's patience is appreciated.

No parking signs will be placed at strategic locations throughout the work area. It is requested that drivers **refrain from parking on Central Avenue on Sunday night** and relocate all vehicles from this area, to avoid impeding the snow removal operation.

Residents located along the Olympic Relay Route are advised to remove vehicles in advance of the run so that, should snowfall require plowing during the day on Monday along the route parked cars will not impede such work or interfere with the relay starting that evening.

Depending on weather conditions encountered over the weekend, snow removal operations may be conducted along the entire route on Monday, January 11 with little or no advanced notice.

The Route affects the following streets:

- 2nd Avenue West, Marquis Road to 28th Street
- 28th Street, 2nd Avenue West to 6th Avenue East
- 6th Avenue East, 28th Street to 22nd Street
- 22nd Street East, 6th Avenue to Central Avenue
- Central Avenue, 22nd Street to 10th Street
