Modified Snow Removal to clear streets

Means ridges across driveways in the interim

“We are clearing roadways around the city as a priority and to help speed that up we will be going into some areas and not clearing the entrances to driveways, initially. We’ll be back to do those later, but in the interim we are asking neighbors to help neighbors in clearing ridges left by the plows across driveways until we get back to do that,” requests City Manager Robert Cotterill.

Cotterill explains, “This is all in an attempt to ensure all areas of the city obtain some level of snow removal. There is a lot of snow to clear and if we do the driveway entrances it could be days before we get to some subdivisions, so we are speeding up road clearing and asking people to pitch-in for moving driveway blockages until we come back and do those. This is where real northern climate residents really meet the challenges of winter and we know we can count on that ‘get it done’ attitude to weather this storm.”
