Media Press Conference – Elimination of Racial Discrimination Week

The Elimination of Racial Discrimination Week is March 15 -21. The City of Prince Albert's Race Relations and Social Issues Committee has coordinated several events to observe this International Day to raise awareness, engage the community, and generate dialogue. Our theme is “Growing in the Shelter of Each Other.”

The week commences with the Mayor's Meet and Greet Gathering at City Hall Foyer on Monday, March 15 at 2:00 pm. The Mayor will proclaim the week. Councilor Cheryl Ring will outline the week's activities. Entertainment and refreshments will follow. The City invites the community and the media to attend this event.

The Committee invites the community to join Share-a-Meal on Tuesday, March 16 at 3:00 pm (donations accepted), and the Indian Métis Friendship Centre on Wednesday, March 17 at 12:00 (cost of \$3) for a meal.

Friday, March 19, marks the first Random Acts of Kindness Day. Citizens are being challenged to do an act of kindness on this day. The Committee is further challenging children and youth to document their experience through a short essay or poster, which can be submitted through their school or directly to lnosbush@citypa.com. The community at large is also encouraged to record their experience and forward them to City Hall.
