Survey Work on Diefenbaker Bridge

Reduced Speed Limit – 30 km/hr to accommodate survey work

The City of Prince Albert wishes to advise motorists that the speed limit for southbound traffic on the Diefenbaker Bridge will be reduced to 30 km/hr near the River Street exit cloverleaf to accommodate survey work occurring adjacent to the roadway. The most westerly lane will be closed to facilitate the survey, however, both through lanes will be available for traffic, and no additional disruption is anticipated. Work is expected to begin after 9:00am, Friday, March 26, 2010, and should be completed by the end of the day.

Motorists are reminded to use caution when approaching the work zone area, and to watch for men/women and equipment working adjacent to the roadway. The City thanks motorists for their patience and understanding during this period.
