## Dates Set for Pitch-In Month

The City of Prince Albert, Prince Albert Tourism, the Parkland Health Region and the Downtown Improvement District will once again be coordinating Pitch-in Month as a way to combat the trash and keep Prince Albert beautiful. The campaign kicks-off with in conjunction with the start of the Free Week at the Landfill on Monday, April 19<sup>th</sup> and the downtown clean-up and breakfast at City Hall on Earth Day - Saturday, April 24<sup>th</sup> at 8:00 a.m. Afterwards, Earth Day activities will take place at Memorial Square – City Hall starting at 1:00 p.m.

The success of Pitch-In effort rests on the volunteers that come out to help clean up. The following dates have been designated for the community to focus on litter pick-up:
