Street Sweeping in Residential Areas

Crews Will Be Out Starting Tuesday, May 25th

The City of Prince Albert has recently finished street sweeping on the main roads and would like to advise residents that the Public Works Department will be commencing street sweeping in the residential areas starting Tuesday, May 25th. Street sweeping clears sand and debris from City roadways and helps to keep streets safe, clean and beautiful.

Four units will be operating five days per week, weather permitting. It is expected that the sweeping will be concluded within 6-7 weeks unless weather conditions create significant delays. Major roadways in the City have already been completed and crews will continue sweeping these roads throughout the summer season.

Sweeping in residential areas will be done in the following order:

1. Midtown
2. East Flat/Riverview
3. Crescent Heights, Crescent Acres, Carlton Park
4. East Hill
5. West Hill
6. West Flat/Westview
7. Nordale/Hazeldell/North Industrial

Residential areas will be signed 24 hours in advance of any street sweeping. Residents can help out City crews by ensuring that parked vehicles are moved from signed areas. The removal of the parked vehicles will allow crews to thoroughly clean all areas of the street. The schedule is subject to modification depending on when garbage and recycling collection is scheduled for pick-up in each area.
