City Announces Free Bus Service Will Be Offered

The City of Prince Albert is pleased to announce that once again, it will be participating in National Clean Air Day by offering free bus services on Wednesday, June 2, 2010. National Clean Air Day is celebrated in conjunction with Environment week and the National Commuter Challenge which promotes the use of alternative forms of transportation, including Public Transit.
