## **New Low Floor Bus Goes Into Service**

*Service Starts on June 2, 2010 on the All Day Express Route*

The City has purchased a new low floor bus for the All Day Express bus route. This bus will be in service starting June 2, 2010. June 2, 2010 is Clean Air Day and transit service is free, so come out and try out the new bus and see how you can use Transit today and everyday.

The new bus has many customer friendly features including a floor system that allows for easy access and exiting from the bus and the addition of a front bicycle rack. . The low floor bus improves access to Public Transit service for persons with canes, crutches, walkers, young children or burdensome packages. It is also possible for those who use wheelchairs to access the Public Transit Service. A low floor bus has no steps to get in and a ramp can be deployed if necessary.

The bike rack improves service for those who wish to ride their bike one way and ride the bus the other way, or you can ride your bike to the nearest All Day Express bus stop, and get on and ride the rest of the way. If you live on the hill and work downtown the bike racks provides a great way to incorporate active transportation into your day even if you only like to ride down the hill and are too tired to ride back up the hill at the end of the day. The new bus also has increased seating, a rear door and has significantly lower emissions than the rest of the bus fleet.
