Opening Day for Kinsmen Water Park set for June 4, 2010

The Kinsmen Water Park located on the corner of 28th Street East and 1st Avenue West in Prince Albert will be opening for the season on Friday, June 4th, 2010 at 4 p.m. The admission fee on opening day will be half of regular admission prices. Beginning Saturday, June 5th, the Kinsmen Water Park will be open every day from 1 p.m. to 7 p.m. weather permitting.

The Kinsmen Water Park is one of the major aquatic facilities in Northern Saskatchewan and features a large outdoor swimming pool, whirlpool, tot pool, junior slide, two giant slides running over 300 feet in length and a river slide. In addition, there is play equipment for youngsters, a concession and ample leisure space for family games and activity.

This year, season passes will be available allowing children, students and adults the convenience of visiting the Kinsmen Water Park as often as they desire all summer long for one admission fee. Registrations are now being accepted for swimming lessons at the KWP and bookings are now being accepted for after-hour rentals. Ball teams, year end school bookings and family socials are available for private bookings all summer long at the Kinsmen Water Park.
