## **Asphalt Work on 10<sup>th</sup> Avenue West scheduled for Monday, June 28<sup>th</sup>**

*Contractor to complete second lift of asphalt*

The City of Prince Albert wishes to advise residents that traffic on 10<sup>th</sup> Avenue West, between 20<sup>th</sup> and 28<sup>th</sup> Streets, will be restricted while the City's contractor applies the top layer of asphalt in the final phase of the West Hill Infrastructure Project. This work is scheduled to begin Monday, June 28<sup>th</sup> and is expected to be completed by Wednesday morning. The contractor will start on the west side of 10<sup>th</sup> Avenue West on Monday moving to the east side Tuesday, weather permitting.

Traffic will be allowed into the Soccer Centre and Hospital while the work is ongoing. Depending on the positioning of equipment, there may be at times some short delays to access 10<sup>th</sup> Avenue; however emergency traffic will be given immediate priority.

Motorists are reminded to use caution in the work zone area and obey all signage. The City thanks motorists for their patience and understanding during this period.
