City Crews Respond to Major Storm

Prince Albert was hit with a large thunderstorm this evening that caused damage in all areas of the City in particular the South East section of the City. Trees were uprooted and branches broke off many of the City's trees.

City crews are responding and are concentrating on clearing major thorough fares and will be removing tree limbs a represent a safety hazard. Crews will be piling tree branches along the sides of the roads and will be returning next week with a chipping truck to remove the debris.

Residents are advised stay away from storm drains as many of the basins are full of rainwater from the runoff.

City crews are responding to multiple calls. When crews are working in your neighborhood, please assist them by remaining a safe distance away from the work area. If you have not received service by Monday, July 5th, residents can report problem trees on public property by calling 953-4800.
