Province Approves City’s Application for Disaster Assistance

Residents Can Pick Up Applications At City Hall

The Province has approved the City’s Application for Provincial Disaster Assistance as a result of the severe wind and thunder storms on Friday, July 2, 2010.

The Provincial Disaster Assistance Program (PDAP) provides financial assistance to eligible claimants located in a municipality that has been designated eligible for assistance as a result of a substantial loss or damage to uninsurable, essential property caused by specific natural disasters.

Application Forms and Program Information is available at the front desk at City Hall (8:00 a.m. – 4:30 p.m., Monday – Friday). The City is responsible to distribute, collect and submit the completed forms to the PDAP office. Completed applications must be returned to City Hall by December 30th to ensure they are received at the PDAP office by January 2, 2011, and any work must be completed by July 2, 2011.

The PDAP office will assign a claim reference number and mail out an individual information package to claimant with a confirmation of the claim registration.

Applicants will deal directly with the PDAP Adjuster’s office at this point.
