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Province Expands City’s Application for Disaster Assistance from July 2nd Storm to Include Plow Wind

Residents will need to reapply if claiming damage from Plow Wind

The Province has expanded the type of damage residents can apply for as a result of the storm on July 2, 2010, to include damage caused by the Plow Wind. Previously, the government had only considered applications as a result of Rain Damage caused by the storm.

With this recent announcement, residents who had previously claimed for damages caused by the Plow Wind and had their claims denied will need to reapply.

Application Forms are available at the front desk at City Hall (8:00 a.m. – 4:30 p.m., Monday – Friday). Please ensure that when you pick up your form, you ask for the correct type as there is one form for Rain Damage and a separate form for damage caused by the Plow Wind.

Completed applications can either be mailed directly to the Provincial Disaster Assistance Program (PDAP) Office or returned to City Hall by December 30th to ensure they are received at the PDAP office by January 2, 2011. Any work must be completed by July 2, 2011.

The PDAP office will assign a claim reference number and mail out an individual information package to claimant with a confirmation of the claim registration. Applicants will deal directly with the PDAP Adjuster’s office at this point.

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
