Registration Open for January 2011 Swimming Lessons at Frank J. Dunn Pool

Registrations are now being accepted for a new session of swimming lessons being offered at the Frank J. Dunn Pool beginning in January 2011. The City of Prince Albert offers Red Cross Swimming lessons for preschool children 3 to 5 years of age, children six years and up, youth and adults. Advanced classes such as the Assisted Water Safety Instructor program are also offered. Red Cross Swim Kids is a 10 level program that helps swimmers develop all six swimming strokes (front and back crawl, elementary back stroke, breast stroke, butterfly, sidestroke), how to be safe around the water and increase their fitness and endurance through fun activities.
