City Reminds Residents of Snow Removal Policy

With heavy snowfalls just around the corner, the City of Prince Albert would like to remind residents of the three major facets of its snow removal policy:

1. Crews will remove snow from streets based on their priority. Emergency streets are first, school and bus routes second, the downtown third and residential areas last. Maps of these routes can be accessed at www.citypa.ca.
2. Parking bans on priority one emergency routes and major roadways will be declared after major snowfalls. Streets such as 2nd avenue west, 15th street, 4th street, River street and 6th avenue east and west will be subject to these parking restrictions when declared. There has only been one parking ban since the policy was adopted in 2007. These parking bans are for significant snow events only.
3. Property owners are responsible for snow removal on their sidewalks. The City's snow policy requires that residents "Clear the way" for pedestrians, mail carriers and delivery persons. This policy continues to be based on voluntary compliance.
