## **City of Prince Albert to be Presented with COR Certification**

*Certification marks significant milestone for City's Health and Safety Program*

The City of Prince Albert is being presented with a Certificate of Recognition (COR), from the Heavy Construction Safety Association of Saskatchewan (HCSAS) on:

Friday, November 19, 2010

Main Boardroom (2<sup>nd</sup> Floor)  
11:00a.m.

COR is a safety program designed by the HCSAS. In order to be certified, companies with more than 10 employees must complete a series of safety requirements. This includes completion of safety courses, designing and implementing a safety program and conducting an internal and external audit of the program. The City of Prince Albert is the first municipality in the province to be certified according to COR standards.

"This certification marks a significant milestone for the City Of Prince Albert," said Lloyd Gould, Coordinator of Health, Safety and the Environment for the City. "It demonstrates that we have met the standards set out by the HCSAS and that we are following an established safety system."

"It is everyone's duty to work safely," said Joel Friesen, Employee Co-Chair on the City's Occupational Health and Safety Committee. "The certification process has reinforced this concept and has encouraged employees to consider their own safety on the job as well as the safety of those they work with."
