



CITY OF PRINCE ALBERT PUBLIC NOTICE

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO CONSIDER ANIMAL CONTROL BYLAW NO. 17 OF 2003 AND DANGEROUS ANIMAL BYLAW NO. 18 OF 2003; AND THE REPEAL OF (1) DOG LICENSING AND CONTROL BYLAW NO. 29 OF 1989, (2) ANIMAL CONTROL BYLAW NO. 10 OF 1990, AND (3) CAT BYLAW NO. 3 OF 1999.

Pursuant to Section 102 of *The Cities Act, 2002*, the Council of the City of Prince Albert hereby gives notice of its intention to consider Animal Control Bylaw No. 17 of 2003 and Dangerous Animal Bylaw No. 18 of 2003; and to consider repealing (1) Dog Licensing and Control Bylaw No. 29 of 1989, (2) Animal Control Bylaw No. 10 of 1990, and (3) Cat Bylaw No. 3 of 1999.

Animal Control Bylaw No. 17 of 2003 and Dangerous Animal Bylaw No. 18 of 2003 reflect the new Cities Act legislation that came into affect January 1st, 2003, and current Animal Control issues as identified by Animal Control Officers and representatives of the Prince Albert SPCA. Should City Council pass both Bylaws, the following Bylaws will be repealed: (1) Dog Licensing and Control Bylaw No. 29 of 1989, (2) Animal Control Bylaw No. 10 of 1990, and (3) Cat Bylaw No. 3 of 1999.

Animal Control Bylaw No. 17 of 2003 and Dangerous Animal Bylaw No. 18 of 2003 may be inspected in the Office of the City Clerk, 2nd Floor, City Hall, free of charge between the hours of 8:00 am and 4:30 pm.

Any person may make oral or written representation to City Council at its meeting to be held on Monday, August 25th, 2003 in City Hall Council Chambers, 1084 Central Avenue, Prince Albert, Saskatchewan, S6V 7P3 at 5:00 p.m. Council will hear any person or group who wants to comment on the proposed Bylaws at this time. Council will also consider written comments received at the meeting or that are delivered to the undersigned prior to 4:30 p.m., August 15th, 2003.
