PROPOSED ZONING BYLAW AMENDMENT – BYLAW NO. 4 OF 2012

Public Notice is hereby given that the Council of The City of Prince Albert intends to amend Bylaw No. 1 of 1987, known as The City of Prince Albert Zoning Bylaw. The purpose of Bylaw 4 of 2012 will be to:

Amend Section 22.2 Permitted Uses by adding the following permitted use:

“Personal Service Business” which can be defined as:

“Means a facility for providing a service on a commercial basis to individuals and includes such uses as photography studios, dry-cleaning establishments and barber shops”

Reason for Amendment: Through Bylaw No. 4 of 2012, a “Personal Service Business” will be a permitted use within an M1 – Heavy Industrial Zone.

Therefore, City Council, at its meeting to be held on Monday, February 13th, 2012 at 5:00 p.m., will consider ALL submissions either orally or written respecting the above application until that date and time. In accordance with City Council’s Procedure Bylaw No. 10 of 2005, all written submissions must be signed and provided to the City Clerk. If you would like your written submission reviewed by members of Council prior to the meeting, it would be preferable to provide your submission by 4:45 p.m. on Tuesday, February 7th 2012.
