Council Approves 2nd Avenue West Infrastructure Improvements

Prince Albert City Council has approved a recommendation to go ahead with a \$520,000 infrastructure repair project for a portion of 2nd Avenue West (28th to 32nd street). Last winter this portion of 2nd avenue encountered several water main breaks which disrupted traffic and businesses in the area. The repair work will extend the life of the watermains in this area and is expected to prevent any further disruptions.

“During budget deliberations City Council directed Administration to make the repairs along 2nd avenue a priority for this construction season,” said Colin Innes, Director of Public Works for the City of Prince Albert. “To avoid disruption during the busy summer months, we have decided to bring the matter forward for this fall.”

The repair work will begin Wednesday, September 10, 2008 and is expected to take up to 2 or 3 weeks to complete with construction finalized before the end of September. Southbound traffic along this portion of 2nd Avenue will be restricted to one lane for the duration of the project.
