Purpose:		
To outline how to safely clean the KWP vertical pump strainer baskets.

Scope:

All City of Prince Albert employees and contracted, certified scuba divers.

Hazards:

- Minor Injuries
- Entrapment
- Electrocution
- Drowning
- Sudden Death

General Work Procedure:

When the pool is empty:

- 1. Vertical pumps should be locked out at all times the pool is empty.
- 2. Remove grate into the pit under the slides.
- 3. Remove each basket, clean, and replace.

When the pool is full:

- 1. Turn off pumps for slides. Lock out the vertical pumps. Give the keys to the scuba diver.
- 2. Remove the grate into the pit under the slides.
- 3. Scuba diver should inspect their equipment prior to diving.
- 4. A lifeguard must enter the water with goggles and be at the bottom of the river ride in order to see the scuba diver in the pit under the pump house. A lifeguard must also be on the deck.
- 5. Scuba diver must remove each basket and give to staff on the deck.
- 6. Staff on deck must clean all debris off the strainer baskets.

- 7. Scuba diver should use pool skimmer head to clean debris from bottom of pit and around impellors.
- 8. Scuba diver must replace strainer baskets over impellors. Ensure anodes are attached.
- 9. Replace grate.
- 10. Lifeguard and scuba diver must exit water.
- 11. Unlock vertical pumps.
- 12. Skim debris off surface of pool and from bottom.
- 13. Turn on slides if necessary.

To clean the strainer basket:

- 1. Pull off debris with a metal brush.
- 2. Hose the strainer basket.

Emergency Rescue of Scuba Diver:

- 1. The lifeguard in the water will know the scuba diver needs assistance if:
 - a. The scuba diver is not moving and appears unconscious.
 - b. The scuba diver has indicated they need help.
- 2. The lifeguard on deck will call 911 and signal to other available staff members of a major emergency (1 long whistle blast).
- 3. The lifeguard in the water will enter the pit, and remove the scuba diver into the regular pool area.
- 4. If the lifeguard cannot accomplish this in 1 breath, other lifeguards will assist.
- 5. Remaining rescue as per ERP.
