

**CITY OF PRINCE ALBERT**

**BYLAW NO. 15 of 2001**

**A Bylaw to Designate as Municipal Heritage Property the property legally described as Lots 62 – 64, Block 5, Plan E, River Lot 78, Except: The most Northerly ten feet throughout.**

WHEREAS Part III of the Heritage Property Act authorizes the Council of a Municipality to enact Bylaws to designate real property, including all buildings and structures thereon to be of architectural, historical or natural value or interest;

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of Prince Albert has caused a Notice of Intention to be prepared to designate the real property at 94 15<sup>th</sup> Street East and has served such Notice of Intention upon the registered owners of the said property at least Thirty (30) days prior to final consideration of this Bylaw;

AND WHEREAS the said Council has caused the said Notice of Intention to designate to be published in an issue of the Prince Albert Daily Herald at least Thirty (30) days prior to final consideration of this bylaw;

AND WHEREAS no objection to the proposed designation has been served on the City Clerk of the Municipality;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PRINCE ALBERT IN OPEN MEETING ASSEMBLED ENACTS AS FOLLOWS;

1. There is designated as Municipal Heritage Property being of architectural and historical value and interest the property at 94 – 15<sup>th</sup> Street East legally described as Lots 62 – 64, Block 5, Plan E, River Lot 78, Except: The most Northerly ten feet throughout.
2. The City Solicitor is hereby authorized to cause a certified copy of this Bylaw to be registered against the property described above in the Land Titles Office for the Prince Albert Land Registration District.
3. The City Clerk is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this bylaw to be filed with the City of Prince Albert and a copy of this bylaw to be served on the Minister of


Municipal Affairs, Culture and Housing, and to cause notice of the passing of this Bylaw.

4. The Council hereby delegates approving authority for proposed Internal alterations to the building at 94 -- 15<sup>th</sup> Street East, to the Director of Planning and Economic Development.
