CITY OF PRINCE ALBERT BYLAW NO. 68 OF 1957

A Bylaw of the City of Prince Albert to provide for the adoption of a Coat of Arms and Crest by the City.

WHEREAS the Council of the City of Prince Albert deems it desirable that a Crest and Coat of Arms for the City be adopted; AND WHEREAS the Council by its Finance Committee on March 28, 1952, instructed the City Clerk to Communicate with the College of Arms of London, England, in respect thereto;

AND WHEREAS on November 15, 1954, the said committee instructed the City Clerk to make application to the said College of Arms for the issue of a Grant of Arms;

AND WHEREAS on October 1, 1956, the City Council decided to adopt as the City's motto for inclusion in the said Coat of Arms the words "Proud Heritage Bod Destiny";

AND WHEREAS upon representation by David Gordon Steuart as Mayor of the City of Prince Albert the Most Noble Bernard Marmaduke, Duke of Norfolk, Knight of the Most Noble Order of the Garter, Knight Grand Cross of the Royal Victorian Order, Earl Marshal and Hereditary Marshal of England and One of Her Majesty's Most Honourable Privy Council, issued his warrant in respect thereto;

AND WHEREAS the Honourable Sir George Rothe Bellew, Knight Commander of the Royal Victorian Order, Garter Principal King of Arms, Sir John Dunamace Heaton-Armstrong, Knight, Member of the Royal Victorian Order, Clarenceux, King of Arms and Aubrey John Toppin, Esquire, Member of the Royal Victorian Order, Norroy and Ulster King of Arms pursuant to the said warrant and by virtue of the Several Letters Patent of Their Several Offices, under date of August 1, 1957 and under their respective Seals of Office did grant unto the Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Prince Alber the Arms and Supporters hereinafter described.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PRINCE ALBERT IN OPEN MEETING ASSEMBLED ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Pursuant to the terms of the City Act and by virtue of the said grant dated August 1, 1957, the Crest and Coat of Arms described in the said grant is hereby adopted as set out in the terms of the said grant, namely:

> "The Arms following that is to say:- Vert a Beaver proper between three Grabs Or and for the Crest Issuant from a Coronet Composed of eight Trefoils set upon a Rim Or a White Spruce Tree proper Mantled Vert, doubled Or, as the same are in the margin hereof more plainly depicted. And the Supporters following that is to say:-On the dexter side a Constable of the North West Mounted Police and on the sinister side a North American Indian of the Plain Crees tribe both in late 19th Century dress proper as the same are also in the margin hereof more plainly depicted the whole to be borne and used forever hereafter by the Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Prince Albert on their common seal or otherwise according to the Laws of Arms."

2. This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect on, from and after the final passing thereof and approval thereof by the Lieutenant Governor in Council.
