CHAPTER L-30.11 REG 1
The Local Government Election Act, 2015

PART I
Preliminary Matters

Title

1 These regulations may be cited as *The Local Government Election Regulations, 2015*.

Interpretation

2 (1) In these regulations, “**Act**” means *The Local Government Election Act, 2015*.

(2) For the purposes of sections 36 and 42 of the Act, “**assessed person**” includes the owner of assessable land that has been leased to another person.

(3) For the purposes of section 47.1 of the Act, an emergency is a situation in which the health or safety of persons is at risk, and may include:

- (a)** severe weather;
- (b)** a declared state of emergency; or
- (c)** a public health order preventing the movement or assembly of voters

PART III
Voting Machines

Interpretation of Part

4(1) In this Part:

“**register tape**” means the printed record generated from a voting machine that shows:

- (a)** the total number of ballots received;
- (b)** the number of ballots on which no vote is marked;
- (c)** the number of ballots on which the voter made more votes than the voter is entitled to make;
- (d)** the number of votes for each candidate; and
- (e)** if there is a vote on a bylaw or question, the number of votes for and against each bylaw or question;

“voter-assist terminal” means a voting device used by a voter with a disability to mark a ballot by selecting a candidate using:

- (a) audio only voting;
- (b) a touch screen;
- (c) pressure sensitive paddles;
- (d) punch cards;
- (e) a sip/puff tube; or
- (f) any other device designed to assist voters with a disability;

“voting machine” means any device that records how ballots are marked and produces election results by tabulating votes, including:

- (a) vote recorders;
- (b) optical scan vote tabulators; or
- (c) other similar devices;

“zero tape” means a printed register tape of all totals on the voting machine’s memory card that indicates zero for all categories.

- (2) Parts VIII, IX, X and XI of the Act apply, with any necessary modification, to the use of voting machines except as modified or extended by this Part.

Use of paper ballots

- 5(1) Municipalities must use paper ballots when using voting machines.

- (2) If the voter makes a physical mark on a paper ballot, the municipality must ensure that the voter is able to:

- (a) personally insert the ballot into the voting machine; or
- (b) view an election official inserting the ballot into the voting machine.

- (3) If the voter makes a mark through electronic means such as buttons or a touch screen:

- (a) the electronic ballot must be printed on paper for the voter to insert into a ballot box; and
- (b) the printed ballot must be treated in the same manner as other ballots pursuant to section 142 of the Act.

All counting to be done by voting machine

6(1) If a municipality chooses to conduct an election using voting machines, all counting must be done by voting machines, including the counting of ballots cast in:

- (a) advanced polls;
- (b) special polls;
- (c) election day polls; and
- (d) mail-in ballots.

(2) In the case of machine malfunction or another circumstance in which the machine cannot be used during voting hours, the municipality shall take steps to ensure that the ballots are securely stored in a ballot box and inserted into a voting machine as soon as possible after voting hours in the presence of the deputy returning officer.

Rejected ballots

7(1) Each voting machine must be programmed to accept ballots for which no vote is recorded without requiring an override function or giving an audible indication that the ballot is one for which no vote is recorded.

(2) For the purposes of subsection (1), a ballot for which no vote is recorded is any of the following:

- (a) a ballot on which no vote is marked;
- (b) a ballot on which the voter has made more votes than the voter is entitled to make.

(3) Ballots that are inserted into the voting machine for which no vote is recorded are deemed to be rejected ballots in accordance with section 129 of the Act.

(4) Rejected ballots mentioned in subsection (2) must be recorded as rejected on the Deputy Returning Officer's Statement of Results for Voting Machines in Form AA of Appendix C.

Programming and testing of machines

8(1) A municipality using voting machines shall cause to be conducted, in a manner approved by the municipality, programming and testing on all voting machines and voter-assist terminals before an election.

(2) Subject to subsection (3), a specified time frame and procedures for testing and programming of voting machines must be established by bylaw or resolution.

(3) Voting machines must be programmed and tested no more than six months before the scheduled election.

9 Voting machines must not be connected to the internet at any time before or during a poll.

10 At the close of the poll, the register tape must be printed and attached to the Deputy Returning Officer's Statement of Results for Voting Machines found in Form AA of Appendix C.

Required bylaws

11 A bylaw or resolution passed pursuant to section 90 of the Act must include procedures for:

- (a) the programming and testing of machines pursuant to sections 7 and 8;
- (b) pre-poll logic and accuracy testing, including:
 - (i) specifying who is to conduct logic and accuracy testing;
 - (ii) how voting machines are to be tested; and
 - (iii) the printing of a zero tape before the opening of poll;
- (c) monitoring of voting machines during poll hours by election officials to ensure that the machines are accurately counting each vote;
- (d) sending results to a central location after the close of poll;
- (e) what actions are to be taken in the event a voting machine fails;
- (f) mobile and special polls;
- (g) accommodating voters with disabilities;
- (h) advance voting;
- (i) counting of mail-in ballots if the municipality uses mail-in ballots;
- (j) recounting of votes;
- (k) the secure storage and transport of machines and other hardware, including memory cards, before, during and after the election; and
- (l) any other matter that the council or board considers necessary.

Additional matters

12 The bylaw or resolution passed pursuant to section 90 of the Act may include procedures for:

- (a) marking a ballot;
- (b) informing voters how to properly deposit a ballot;
- (c) post-poll testing of machines; and
- (d) the safekeeping of machines between elections and between the testing of the machines and the opening of the poll.

PART IV
Voter Identification

Interpretation of Part

13 In this Part:

“**address**” means a residential mailing address, legal land description, civic address or post office box number;

“**person**” means a person seeking to vote;

“**valid**” means:

- (a) in the case of documents with an expiry date, not yet expired;
- (b) in the case of documents issued annually, dated within the year in which the election is being held; and
- (c) in the case of documents issued monthly and all other correspondence and documents not mentioned in clause (a) or (b), dated within the six months before the date of the election.

Evidence of residence

15 If the address contained in the piece of identification or pieces of information provided pursuant to clause 110(a) of the Act does not provide evidence of a person’s residence in the municipality but is, in the opinion of the deputy returning officer, consistent with information relating to the person that appears on the voters list or voter’s registration form, the person’s residence is established for the purposes of voting.

Use and disclosure of information

16(1) Every election official, candidate or candidate's agent who, in the course of the person's duties, acquires or accesses any information or document presented by a person as evidence of identity shall:

- (a) keep the information or document confidential; and
- (b) not disclose or make use of the information or document other than for the purpose of providing a ballot to the person to whom the information or document relates.

(2) No election official, candidate or candidate's agent shall copy or record any information or document presented by a person as evidence of that person's identity.

Vouching

17(1) Subject to subsections (2) to (5), a person seeking to vote may prove the person's identity by being accompanied by a voter who is entitled to vote in the same municipality and who:

- (a) for the purpose of establishing the voter's own identity, provides to the deputy returning officer and the poll clerk the piece of identification or pieces of information mentioned in clause 110(a) of the Act; and
- (b) vouches for the person seeking to vote on oath or affirmation in the prescribed form in the presence of the deputy returning officer using Form B of Appendix A.

(2) No voter shall vouch for more than one person in an election unless the persons to be vouched for are living at the same address as the voucher and are related to the voucher in one of the ways set out in Table 2 of Appendix D.

(3) A person who has been vouched for at an election shall not vouch for another person at that election.

(4) No election official shall vouch for the identity of any person.

(5) No candidate or candidate's agent shall vouch for the identity of any person.

Identification for mail-in ballot systems

18(1) A bylaw or resolution establishing a mail-in ballot voting system pursuant to subsection 92(1) of the Act must provide that a person, before being issued a mail-in ballot, shall provide to the returning officer, or other person authorized by the bylaw or resolution, the following:

- (a) subject to subsection (1.2), a voter's registration form completed by the person requesting a mail-in ballot;
- (b) a declaration signed by the person requesting a mail-in ballot that includes:
 - (i) a statement that the person is qualified to vote in the municipality;

- (ii) evidence of the person's identity as set out in section 110 of the Act; and
 - (iii) a statement that the person believes the declaration to be true and knows that it is of the same force and effect as if made under oath or affirmation and by virtue of the *Canada Evidence Act*.
- (1.1) The declaration mentioned in clause (1)(b) may be made:
- (a) in person before the returning office or other person authorized by bylaw or resolution to witness the person's signature; or
 - (b) by registered mail, by ordinary mail, by fax, by email or as otherwise specified in the bylaw or resolution, in which case the declaration must be accompanied by:
 - (i) the person's signature; and
 - (ii) copies of the identification or information provided for the purposes of subclause (1)(b)(ii).
- (1.2) A person requesting a mail-in ballot is not required to complete a voter's registration form if:
- (a) a voters list is being used in the election; and
 - (b) the information provided in the person's declaration made in accordance with subsections (1) and (1.1) matches the information in the voter registry respecting that person
- (2) The bylaw or resolution mentioned in subsection (1) must also provide for:
- (a) the maintenance of the secrecy of mail-in ballots;
 - (b) the inspection of the voter's registration forms and the declarations of persons requesting a mail-in ballot by candidates or candidates' agents on election day and at any other time provided for in the bylaw until the close of polls on election day;
 - (c) the right of candidates or their agents to object to a person's eligibility to vote pursuant to subsection 112(1) and to request pursuant to clause 112(2)(b) of the Act to verify that the procedures set out in clause 110(b) of the Act have been followed;
 - (d) the counting of the mail-in ballots after the close of polls on election day; and
 - (e) the retention and destruction of the mail-in ballots and forms with other election materials pursuant to section 142 of the Act.

PART V
Elections of Board Members Who Represent Indian Reserves

Interpretation of Part

19 In this Part:

“**band**” means a band as defined in the *Indian Act* (Canada), and includes the council of a band;

“**band member**” means a member of a band;

“**chief**” means the chief of a band who is elected in accordance with section 73 of the *Indian Act* (Canada);

“**education committee**” means a group of three or more members of a band who are appointed by the chief or elected by the band to deal with matters on the reserve relating to education;

“**Form**” means a form set out in Appendix B;

“**Indian Reserve subdivision**” means a subdivision consisting of one or more reserves;

“**reserve**” means a reserve as defined in the *Indian Act* (Canada).

“**subdivision**” means a subdivision as defined in *The Education Act, 1995*.

20 Except as otherwise provided in these regulations, the Act and these regulations apply, with any necessary modification, to elections in Indian Reserve subdivisions.

Nomination paper

21(1) Form A is the form prescribed for the nomination paper for an election in an Indian Reserve subdivision.

(2) The form mentioned in subsection (1) must:

(a) be signed by at least five persons who are:

(i) 18 years of age or more; and

(ii) band members residing in the Indian Reserve subdivision; and

(b) contain a part entitled “Candidate’s Acceptance” that is signed by the candidate being nominated.

First election in Indian Reserve subdivision

22 For the first election in an Indian Reserve subdivision, the secretary of the division shall cause to be delivered to the chief of each band council in the subdivision, on or before a date to be determined by the minister to whom for the time being the administration of *The Education Act, 1995* is assigned, at least two copies of Form A.

Poll

23(1) For the first election in an Indian Reserve subdivision, if more than one person is nominated, a poll must be taken in each reserve within or partly within the subdivision:

- (a) on a date to be fixed by the minister to whom for the time being the administration of *The Education Act, 1995* is assigned; and
- (b) at a place designated by the chief of the affected reserve.

(2) In general elections after a first election described in subsection (1), if a poll is required, it must be taken:

- (a) on the date specified in an order made pursuant to section 42 of *The Education Act, 1995*; and
- (b) at a place designated by the chief.

24 In an election in an Indian Reserve subdivision, the chief or the chief's nominee is the deputy returning officer.

Voters

25 In order for a person to be entitled to vote in any election in an Indian Reserve subdivision, the person must:

- (a) be at least 18 years of age; and
- (b) have resided:
 - (i) in the school division in which the poll is taken for at least three consecutive months immediately preceding the day of the election; and
 - (ii) in Saskatchewan for at least six consecutive months immediately preceding the day of the election.

26(1) In an election in an Indian Reserve subdivision, the returning officer shall provide a supply of:

- (a) poll books in Form B;
- (b) registration forms for voters residing on reserves in Form C; and
- (c) the statement of results in Form Z of Appendix C.

(2) The returning officer shall, not later than the day before the day of the poll, deliver to each deputy returning officer a sufficient number of each form mentioned in subsection (1).

27 In an election in an Indian Reserve subdivision, the deputy returning officer shall keep a poll book in Form B in which the poll clerk shall:

- (a) enter the name and residence of each voter; and
- (b) number the entries made pursuant to clause (a) consecutively.

Voter's registration form

28 A person who wishes to vote in an election in an Indian Reserve subdivision shall be permitted to vote if the person establishes the person's eligibility to vote by completing a registration form in Form C.

Notice of person elected

29 The returning officer shall, as soon as is practicable after an election, give written notice of the name and residence of any person elected as a board member in an Indian Reserve subdivision to:

- (a) the minister to whom for the time being the administration of *The Education Act, 1995* is assigned;
- (b) the secretary of each education committee;
- (c) the chiefs of the reserves in the Indian Reserve subdivision; and
- (d) the board of education.

Application to access or remove voter registry information

35(1) For the purposes of clause 53.5(1)(a) of the Act, a person or a person’s agent may apply to have access to information in the voter registry about the person by providing the returning officer with a request, in writing, that contains the following information:

- (a) the person’s full legal name;
- (b) the date of the request;
- (c) the person’s ordinary residential address;
- (d) if submitted by the person’s agent, the agent’s full legal name and mailing address; and
- (e) either:
 - (i) the signature of the person making the request; or
 - (ii) if submitted by the person’s agent, a declaration signed by the agent stating that the agent is authorized to make the request on the person’s behalf.

(2) For the purposes of clause 53.5(1)(b) of the Act, a person or a person’s agent may apply to have the person’s information removed from or not included in the voter registry by providing the returning officer with a request, in writing, that contains the following information:

- (a) the person’s full legal name;
- (b) the date of the request;

- (c) the person's ordinary residential address;
- (d) the person's mailing address if different than the address mentioned in clause (c);
- (e) if submitted by the person's agent, the agent's full legal name and mailing address;
- (f) a statement of confirmation that the person's information is to be removed from or not included in the voter registry;
- (g) a statement of recognition that, if the person's information is removed from or not included in the voter registry:
 - (i) the person's name will not appear on the voters list for municipal and school board elections; and
 - (ii) the person will be required to register at the poll in order to vote; and
- (h) either:
 - (i) the signature of the person making the request; or
 - (ii) if submitted by the person's agent, a declaration signed by the agent stating that the agent is authorized to make the request on the person's behalf.

36 Form H is the notice form prescribed for calling for nominations for the office of mayor, reeve, councillor or board member for the purposes of section 66 of the Act.

37(1) Form I is the form prescribed for the nomination paper in the following circumstances:

- (a) if the nomination paper must be signed by at least 25 voters of a municipality that has a population of 20,000 or more pursuant to clause 67(3)(a), (b) or (g) of the Act;
- (b) if the nomination paper must be signed by at least five voters of a municipality with a population less than 20,000 pursuant to clause 67(3)(c), (d) or (h) of the Act;
- (c) if the nomination paper must be signed by at least two voters of a rural municipality pursuant to subsection 67(4) of the Act.

(2) Form J is the form prescribed for the nomination paper if the nomination paper must be signed by at least 10 voters for a school division for the purposes of clause 67(3)(e) or (f) of the Act.

39 Form L is the form prescribed for calling for further nominations for the purposes of clause 78(1)(b) of the Act.

Poll book or advance poll book

40 The returning officer shall ensure that a poll book or advance poll book, as the case may be:

- (a) numbers each voter sequentially; and
- (b) contains the following information for each voter:
 - (i) the voter's name;
 - (ii) whether the voter was issued a ballot with respect to the election of any of the following:
 - (A) the mayor or reeve;
 - (B) a councillor;
 - (C) a member of a public school board of education;
 - (D) a member of a separate school board of education;
 - (E) a bylaw, resolution or question; and
 - (iii) in accordance with subsection 112(1) of the Act:
 - (A) whether a candidate or a candidate's agent objected to the voter's eligibility to vote; and
 - (B) the name of the person who made the objection.

Ballot paper

41(1) Form N is the form prescribed for the purposes of clause 91(1)(a) of the Act.

(2) The top of the ballot for the office of a member of council must contain a rectangle in which is printed in black ink:

“FOR THE OFFICE OF

Place X in circle to right of name

YOU ARE ENTITLED TO VOTE FOR _____
CANDIDATE(S) FOR THIS OFFICE”.

(3) The top of the ballot for a member of a board of education must contain a rectangle in which is printed in black ink:

“FOR MEMBER OF _____ BOARD OF EDUCATION

Place X in circle to right of name

YOU ARE ENTITLED TO VOTE FOR _____ CANDIDATE(S)”.

(4) The top of the first circle must be at least one millimetre below the lower border of the rectangles mentioned in subsections (2) and (3).

(5) Each circle must be at least one centimetre in diameter.

(6) Each circle must be at least one millimetre from every other circle.

(7) The rectangles mentioned in subsections (2) and (3) and the circles mentioned in subsection (5) must be in the natural colour of the paper.

(8) The names of duly nominated candidates must be arranged in one or more columns.

Bribery

185.1 *A person is deemed to have committed the offence of bribery if that person:*

- (a) *or any other person on that person's behalf, directly or indirectly:*
 - (i) *gives, lends or agrees to give, lend, offer or promise money or valuable consideration, or gives, procures or agrees to give, procure, offer or promise any office, place or employment, to or for any voter or person in order to induce that voter or person to vote or refrain from voting at an election or on a bylaw or question; or*
 - (ii) *does any act described in subclause (i) on account of a voter having voted or having refrained from voting at an election or on a bylaw or question;*
- (b) *or any other person on that person's behalf, directly or indirectly, makes any gift, loan, offer, promise or agreement described in clause (a) to or for any person in order to induce that person to procure or defeat, or endeavour to procure or defeat:*
 - (i) *the election of a candidate;*
 - (ii) *the passing of a bylaw;*
 - (iii) *the result of a vote on a question; or*
 - (iv) *the vote of a voter at an election;*
- (c) *in return for a gift, loan, offer, promise, procurement or agreement, procures, defeats, engages, promises or endeavours to procure or defeat:*
 - (i) *the election of a candidate;*
 - (ii) *the passing of a bylaw;*
 - (iii) *the result of a vote on a question; or*
 - (iv) *the vote of a voter at an election;*
- (d) *advances, pays or causes to be paid money to or for the use of any other person, with the intent that the money or any part of it be spent in bribery at an election or at the voting on a bylaw or question, or knowingly pays or causes to be paid money to any person in discharge or repayment of money wholly or in part spent in bribery at an election or at the voting on the bylaw or question;*

(e) or any other person on that person's behalf, before or during an election or before or during the voting on a bylaw or question, directly or indirectly, receives, agrees or contracts for any money, gift, loan or valuable consideration, office, place or employment for that person or any other person for:

- (i) voting or agreeing to vote at the election or on the bylaw or question; or
- (ii) refraining or agreeing to refrain from voting, at the election or on the bylaw or question;

(f) or any other person on that person's behalf, after an election or the voting on a bylaw or question, directly or indirectly:

- (i) receives any money or valuable consideration on account of any person having voted or refrained from voting; or
- (ii) induces any other person to vote or refrain from voting at the election or on the bylaw or question; or

(g) hires a vehicle for the purpose of transporting voters to or from the polls, or receives pay for the use of a vehicle for the purpose of transporting voters to and from a poll.

Undue Influence

185.11(1) In this section, "**threatens**" means:

- (a) makes use of or threatens to make use of any force, violence or restraint;
- (b) inflicts or threatens the infliction personally or by or through any other person of any injury, damage, harm or loss; or
- (c) in any manner practises intimidation.

(2) A person is deemed to have committed the offence of undue influence if that person or any other person on that person's behalf, directly or indirectly:

- (a) threatens any person in order to induce or compel any person to vote or refrain from voting, or to vote for or against a particular candidate, bylaw or question, at an election, or on account of a voter having voted or refrained from voting at an election; or
- (b) by abduction, duress or any fraudulent device or contrivance:
 - (i) impedes, prevents or otherwise interferes with the free exercise of the franchise of a voter; or
 - (ii) compels, induces or prevails on a voter to give or refrain from giving the voter's vote, or to vote for or against a candidate, bylaw or question, at an election.

Forfeiture and disqualification

185.21 A candidate elected at an election who is found by a judge, on the hearing of a motion in the nature of a quo warranto, to be guilty of an act of bribery pursuant to section 185.1 or of using undue influence pursuant to section 185.11 forfeits the candidate's seat and is ineligible as a candidate at any election for 12 years.

Penalty for bribery or undue influence

185.22(1) A person who is found guilty of an offence within the meaning of section 185.1 or 185.11 is:

- (a) liable to a fine of not more than \$5,000, payable to the local jurisdiction on behalf of which the election was conducted; and*
 - (b) disqualified from voting at any election or on any bylaw or question for the next four consecutive years.*
- (2) The penalty imposed in this section is recoverable with full costs of suit by any person who sues for the penalty in court, and a person against whom judgment is rendered is ineligible either as a candidate or a voter until the full amount of the penalty has been paid.*
- (3) The judge may direct that, in default of payment of the penalty and costs within the time fixed, the person against whom judgment is rendered must be imprisoned for the lesser of the following periods:*
- (a) 30 days; or*
 - (b) until the day on which the penalty and costs are fully paid.*
- (4) In case of default of payment, the judge may issue a warrant for the arrest and imprisonment of the person against whom judgment is rendered in accordance with the judgment until the penalty and costs are fully paid.*


