## What you need to know about the Responsible Pet Ownership Bylaw No. 26 of 2018

A pet can be a wonderful addition to your family; however, owners should be aware of the responsibilities that come with having a household pet. The City of Prince Albert's Responsible Pet Ownership Bylaw is in effect. Please see the below list of common offences and fine amounts.

-  Failure to license a cat or dog or failure to attach valid license when off your property.  
**\$75 First Offence**
-  Dog or cat being at large.  
**\$75 First Offence**
-  Unless on your property, dog or cat feces must be removed immediately from public or private property.  
**\$75 First Offence**
-  Allowing animal feces to accumulate on private property.  
**\$75 First Offence**
-  Leaving a cat or dog unattended in a vehicle.  
**\$100 First Offence**
-  Dogs or cats must not chase, bite or injure people.  
**\$100 First Offence**
-  Exceeding the maximum number of animals. 5 cats & dogs total, with a max of 3 dogs.  
**\$75 First Offence**
-  Willfully open a gate or door, untie or free an animal.  
**\$75 First Offence**
-  Abandonment of an animal.  
**\$200 First Offence**
-  Tease or throw things at a confined animal.  
**\$75 First Offence**
