Waste Collection and Disposal Bylaw No. 8 of 2018

## BYLAW RESPONSIBILITIES

Curbside bins left on the street are at a greater risk of vandalism and get in the way of on-street parking spaces.

**LEAVING YOUR BIN ON THE CURB OR BACK LANE PUTS YOU AT RISK FOR A FINE.**

Fines:     1st offence: \$100  
              2nd offence: \$200

## **GARBAGE AND RECYCLING PICK-UP**

To be picked up, garbage and recycling bins need to be placed out on the front curb of your property (or back lane if applicable).

### **IMPORTANT TIMES TO NOTE:**

#### **Before your bin is picked up**

Bins must be put out before 7:30a.m. on your collection day. Bins can also be put out the day before your collection day anytime after 4:00pm.

#### **After your bin is picked up**

Bins must be removed from the curb and placed back onto your property before noon the day after your collection day.

## **COLLECTION CALENDARS**
