Subject: AARC Construction Update


The following work was completed to the end of September 2022.


- Installation of CFA Piles. By the end of the month the majority of the piles in the Arenas were complete and will continue in the Lobby and Aquatics area in October.
- Grade beams were being formed in the dressing room area of the Arenas. The first section of grade beams (South Arenas dressing rooms) was poured on September 30.
- Forming of elevator pit slab and elevator walls.
- Pre-installation meetings were held with formwork, rebar and mechanical subcontractors.
- Swimming tank pool pre-installation meetings were held with the Consultants and applicable subtrades.
- Clunie Consulting and Engineering Ltd continues to perform concrete and compaction testing as required.
 P. Machibroda Engineering Ltd. has been completing ongoing pile inspections.
- Piling was delayed due to rain on September 19 & 20. An additional piling rig was mobilized to minimize schedule impact. Graham forecasted extension of time is current at 0 days.
- Safety; 113 safety orientations to date, 0 incidents.
- Labour; 4,278 hours in September, 9,174 hours to date.
- First progress claim has been submitted and paid. August 2022 progress claim has been submitted.
