RE: 2026 Sanitary Main & Road Rehabilitation Laurier Drive (North Leg) & Park Avenue

The City of Prince Albert Public Works Department would like to advise residents that Laurier Drive (North Leg) and Park Avenue are scheduled for a Capital Utility & Paving Project during the 2026 Construction season. The project location is highlighted below in **orange**.

Sanitary Main Rehabilitation:

The scope of the project includes conventional excavation and replacement of approximately 85 meters of 200mm vitrified clay sanitary sewer main (originally installed in 1966) located beneath Laurier Drive (North Leg) and Park Avenue. These locations are highlighted in **Red**. It is noteworthy that actual site conditions encountered during excavation may require adjustments to the planned scope of work. During certain stages of construction, crews may request that residents temporarily limit sanitary sewer use.

Construction activities will involve open excavations, which may result in short-term restrictions to on-street parking, driveway access, and local traffic movements. Throughout the project, access to 6th Avenue West will be maintained via Laurier Drive (North Access) or Laurier Drive (South Access) at all times.

Later in the season, approximately 82 meters of 200mm diameter Vitrified Clay Sanitary Main (installed in 1966) is tentatively scheduled to be relined with a Cured-in-place-pipe liner (Highlighted in **Green**). This process is trenchless and will have limited impact on residents.

Road Rehabilitation:

Upon completion of the sanitary main relining and sanitary replacement, roadway rehabilitation will take place. This includes asphalt milling, paving and concrete repairs. A notice will be provided to residents in the coming weeks to present further details regarding the roadway rehabilitation portion of this project.

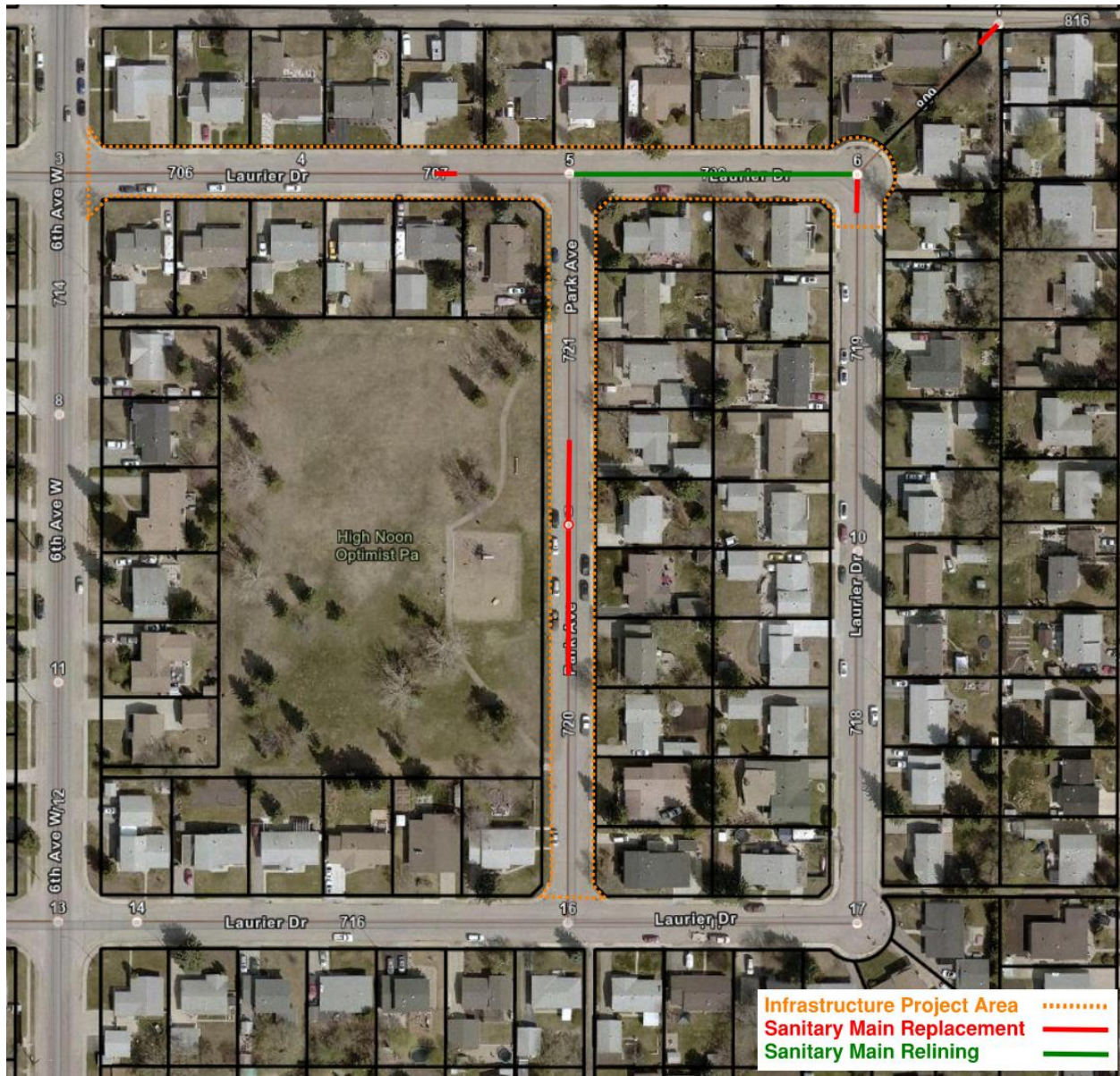
