## CITY OF PRINCE ALBERT BYLAW NO. 4 OF 2003

A Bylaw of the City of Prince Albert to Dispense with the Preparation of Assessment Notices

WHEREAS Section 184(2) of The Cities Act provides that a council may dispense with the preparation of assessment notices if the assessed value of a property:

- (a) has not changed from the previous year's assessed value; or
- (b) the increase or decrease in assessed value does not exceed the lesser of:
  - (i) \$1,000 from the previous year's assessed value; and
  - (ii) 1% of the previous year's assessed value;

AND WHEREAS, it is deemed advisable to enact a Bylaw to dispense with the preparation of assessment notices in the City of Prince Albert;

NOW THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PRINCE ALBERT IN OPEN MEETING ASSEMBLED ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That the Assessor of the City of Prince Albert shall dispense with the preparation of assessment notices if the assessed value of a property:
  - (a) has not changed from the previous year's assessed value; or
  - (b) the increase or decrease in assessed value does not exceed the lesser of:
    - (i) \$1,000 from the previous year's assessed value; and
    - (ii) 1% of the previous year's assessed value.
- 2. This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect on, from and after the final passing thereof.
- 3. Bylaw No. 65 of 2001 is hereby repealed.
