

Alfred's Sprayground, located in Crescent Heights officially opens

Prince Albert, Sk. – The City of Prince Albert is pleased to officially open Alfred's Sprayground, located on Cook Drive in Crescent Heights. With significant financial support from Malcolm Jenkins of Canadian Tire, the spray park spans 3900 square feet. The total cost for this project was \$350,000, made possible through partnering with the Malcolm Jenkins Family Foundation, which contributed \$230,000, and the City of Prince Albert, \$120,000.

The Spray Park features include:

- Acrylic Tot Show Dome
- Aqua Gather
- Flash Flood
- Mini Flash Flood
- Tot Size Well Spring
- Whirlflex
- Triple Arch Jet
- Junior Water Jewel
