BYLAW NO. 62 OF 1993

A Bylaw of the City of Prince Albert to establish the number of Wards in the City of Prince Albert

WHEREAS the Council of the City of Prince Albert at a regular meeting held on the 16th day of November, A.D. 1908, passed Bylaw No. 21 of 1908, which provided that the number of Councillors to be elected shall be eight (8);

AND WHEREAS Section 25 of The Urban Municipality Act, 1984, as amended by The Urban Municipality Amendment Act, 1993, requires the establishment of wards to ensure that the Councillors to be elected at the next general municipal election are elected to represent the wards into which the City is divided;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PRINCE ALBERT IN OPEN MEETING ASSEMBLED ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- That this bylaw may be cited as the Establishment of Wards Bylaw, 1993.
- That the City of Prince Albert shall be divided into eight (8) wards.
- 3. That the wards shall be numbered one (1) to eight (8), both numbers inclusive.
- 4. That the City Clerk shall apply to the Minister of Municipal Government to have the boundaries established for the wards contemplated in Section 2 of this bylaw by the Municipal Wards Commission.

- 5. The City Commissioners shall determine and cause to be paid the remuneration and expenses of the members of the Municipal Wards Commission.
- 6. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on from, and after, the final passing thereof.
