CITY OF PRINCE ALBERT

BYLAW NO. 40 OF 1988

A Bylaw to provide for penalties in certain
Bylaws.

WHEREAS it is deemed advisable to enact a general Penalty
Bylaw.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PRINCE ALBERT IN
OPEN MEETING ASSEMBLED ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as the General Penalty Bylaw.
2. (i) In any Bylaw in which no maximum penalty for an offence under such Bylaw is set out, upon conviction for any such offence, the offender shall be liable to a penalty of not more than:
 - (a) Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00) in the case of an individual;
 - (b) Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) in the case of a corporation.

(ii) For any continuing offence of a Bylaw for which no maximum daily penalty for such continuing offence is set out, the offender shall be liable to a penalty of not more than Two Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$250.00) for each day during which the offence continues.
3. In accordance with the provisions of Section 92(3) of The Urban Municipality Act, 1984, in case penalties are fixed by a Bylaw at sums not exceeding Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) each for one (1) or more specified infractions thereof, such penalties may be paid by the person committing the breach to the Chief of Police or to the City Treasurer within fourteen (14) days of the committing of the offence and upon payment as so provided, such person shall not be liable to prosecution for the offence.
4. Bylaw No. 25 of 1974 is hereby repealed.
5. This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect on, from and after the final passing thereof.
