Dear Parents/Guardians,

The Parks, Recreation, and Culture Department would like to welcome all participants **ages 6 – 12 years** to the Playground Program! This drop-in program is intended to provide children with access to structured environment of sport, arts, culture, and recreation programming throughout the summer months. Parents or guardians are encouraged to attend the playground while children are participating in programs with the trained play leaders.

Playground Hours of Operation:

Monday to Friday: 11:30 AM - 5:00 PM

Playground Program Information:

- This is a drop-in program; children can come and go as they please. It is not a babysitting service.
- Parents/Guardians are encouraged to stay at the playground and supervise their children while the play leaders are conducting the program.
- Playground leaders will do their best to maintain a safe play environment for all children. During hours of operation, they will be available to assist children in distress (example, medical attention).

Rules and Expectations:

- The safety and enjoyment of the program by all participants is important.
- While participating in the program activities, children will be expected to follow playground rules and get along with others.
- Children that engage in inappropriate behavior including rude or harassing comments or aggressive actions towards others may be banned from attending the program.
- The City reserves the right to ban a child from the program for any duration of time up to and including the remainder of the season where considered appropriate.

Special Events (Bus):

- Due to budget cuts, there will be no Thursday special events this summer. Kidzfest will resume.

Playground Field Trips (Walking):

- Field trips may take place from select playgrounds. Permission slips with parental consent are required for all children to participate.
- Information and permission slips will be distributed several days before the trip.
