1 POLICY

- 1.01 That Center lines which separate traffic flows in opposing directions be painted on the following roadways.
 - Roadways designated as Arterials or Collectors in the Arterial and Collector Map as per the Transportation Master Plan.
 - Roadways with a Traffic Volume measured above 2000 AADT.
 - Roadways with a Traffic Volume measured above 1000 AADT and have a school or bus route along the length of the roadway.
- 1.02 That lane lines which separate the traffic flows in the same direction be painted in all areas designated as having two or more lanes in the same direction.
- 1.03 Two- way left turn lanes which indicate the location of two-way left turn lanes be painted in areas where a two way left turn lane has been installed.

2 PURPOSE

2.01 To define where Longitudinal Markings will be painted in the City of Prince Albert.

3 SCOPE

3.01 This statement of policy and procedure applies to all City employees and contractors hired to paint longitudinal markings.

4 RESPONSIBILITY

4.01 The Public Works Department is responsible for ensuring that lines are painted as per policy.

5 DEFINITIONS

- 5.01 Center Lines Directional dividing lines which separate the traffic flows in opposing directions, painted in yellow
- 5.02 Lane Lines white lines painted which separate traffic flows in the same direction
- 5.03 Two way left turn lanes a lane reserved in the centre of a road for exclusive use of left turning vehicles and is not to be used for passing or travel by a driver except to make a left turn.
- 5.04 AADT Annual Average Daily Traffic As recorded on the City of Prince Albert Traffic Volume Map.

6 REFERENCES and RELATED STATEMENTS of POLICY and PROCEDURE

6.01 All roadway markings shall comply with the Transportation Association of Canada Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Canada.

7 PROCEDURE

7.01 The Public Works Department will ensure that Center Lines, Lane Lines, and Two-way left turn lanes will be painted as per policy an as detailed in the line painting schedule kept in Public Works Files.
