BYLAW NO. 54 OF 1983

A Bylaw of The City of Prince Albert
to regulate the use of safety lights on
school buses within the boundaries of
the City of Prince Albert

WHEREAS subsection (3) of Section 86 of The Vehicles Act, 1983, provides that the Council of a municipality may make bylaws prohibiting the use of safety lights on a highway located within its boundaries;

AND WHEREAS Council deems it is advisable to pass such a bylaw for the purpose of orderly and safe traffic conditions.

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PRINCE ALBERT ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The driver of a school bus shall not activate the safety lights before stopping to load or unload school children on any highway within the boundaries of the City of Prince Albert unless driving on a highway with a posted speed limit of sixty (60) kilometres per hour or more.
2. The provisions of this Bylaw shall not take effect until the date that Sections 85 and 86 of The Vehicles Act, 1983, come into force by proclamation of the Lieutenant Governor of Saskatchewan.
3. This Bylaw shall come into force after final passing thereof and approval by the Highway Traffic Board of Saskatchewan.
